

Guidance Note for allotments sheds/greenhouses/polytunnels

This advice is intended for site Secretaries or site representative(s) responsible for granting permission to allotment tenants to erect any structure on their allotment.

- 1. At the time the tenancy is offered, the secretary should make clear to the tenant that permission is required prior to erecting a structure.
- The maximum area permitted to be covered by any structure is 80 square feet (7.4 square metres) per 10 pole (165 feet/50 metres) plot, ie 5 pole (82.5 feet/25.15 metres) plot should not exceed 40 square feet (3.7 square metres).
- 3. Any structure should not exceed 6 feet 6 inches (2metres) in height to the eaves and a maximum of 8 feet (2.4 metres) to the ridge, In the case of a flat structure the maximum height is not to exceed 6 feet 6 inches (2 metres).
- 4. The location is to be agreed with the secretary of site representative
- 5. The tenant should be encouraged to purchase a pre-fabricated structure. However, if the tenant chooses to use suitable materials, the structure should be sound and safe. The finish must be in keeping with the surroundings eg treated with a suitable preservative or painted dark green or brown.
- 6. The permission granted is not intended to imply any form of planning permission and it is the responsibility of the tenant to check and comply with any planning, building regulations.
- 7. The tenant maybe required to remove any structure on termination of their tenancy.
